## Call for Abstracts for Oral and Poster Presentations AAPS-RMDG Annual Meeting, June 12-13, Seattle, WA

- Abstracts for oral and poster presentations are being accepted for the AAPS RMDG Annual Meeting, to be held at the University of Washington, Seattle, WA on June 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Abstracts in all areas of pharmacy, pharmaceutical sciences, analytical chemistry, biomedical and clinical sciences, and related areas will be considered.
- The deadline for submission is May 18. Authors will be informed of acceptance by May 25.
- Please upload your completed abstracts before the submission deadline.
- Presenting authors must be registered for the conference and should be present to discuss their work during the break periods.
- Posters will be displayed on June 12 and 13. Posters will be displayed on panels 4 feet wide by 3 feet high.
- All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by a scientific review committee. Posters presented should contain original work. However, work presented elsewhere within the last 12 months will be considered. Work that has been presented elsewhere must be clearly acknowledged at the end of the abstract with the name of the meeting, the date of the original presentation, and reference to the publication if the abstract has been published.

## **Instructions for Preparing Abstracts**

- The length of the body of the abstract should be between 200 to 300 words.
- Use Microsoft Word, Times New Roman Font, 12-point, single-spaced. Use the Symbol font for symbols and Greek characters. Do not add any styles such as headings.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English, must contain an adequate body of data, and be free
  of typographical errors. Please proofread and spell-check abstract before submitting, as it
  will be printed exactly as it appears when submitted.
- Include the title of your abstract (bold), followed by the authors' full names (first name, last name format) and affiliations. Affiliations must be annotated with superscripted numbers.
   Underline the presenting author's name.
- Prepare the main text under the bolded headings: Purpose, Methods, Results, Conclusion.
- A small table of data and/or small figure may be included.
- Naming your file submission: Name as presenting author's last (family) name. For multiple submissions, submit a separate form for each abstract, and label with the last name and number: e.g.,. Smith\_1, Smith\_2.
